2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 3 weeks.

3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 3 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.

4. Termination of the agreement

A notice of at least one academic year should be given for the termination of the agreement. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 August 20XX will only take effect as of 1 August 20XX+1. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

E. Information

1. Grading systems of the institutions

In the Bulgarian System, marks are graded from 2 to 6, with 3 being the minimum score required to pass:

Отличен (6)	Excellent performance
Много Добър (5)	Very good performance
Добър (4)	Good performance
Среден (3)	Acceptable performance
Слаб (2)	Insufficient performance
Не се явил	Exam not done by the student

Romanian grading scale – 1 to 10, 10 being the maximum grade: ECTS is given if 5 is obtained.

10 – EXCELLENT – outstanding performance with only minor errors

9 – VERY GOOD – above the average standard but with some errors

8 – GOOD – generally sound work with a number of notable errors

6, 7 – SATISFACTORY – fair but with significant shortcomings

5 – SUFFICIENT – performance meets the minimum criteria

4 – FAIL – some more work is required before the credit can be awarded

1, 2, 3 – FAIL – considerable further work is required
