- 3.1. PL LODZ01: A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than [5] weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 3.2. BG PLOVDIV 04: A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than **3** weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

A notice of at least one academic year should be given for the termination of the agreement. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 August 20XX will only take effect as of 1 August 20XX+1. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
