THE BUILDINGS

- The University of Plovdiv has new dormitories that were built just a few years ago. They offer affordable yet comfortable accommodation, providing students with the most essential utilities, so that they can carry out their training in a relaxed and agreeable environment.



- The dormitory is right next to the University's New Campus, on 236 Bulgaria Blvd., Plovdiv, where the faculties of Education and Mathematics and Informatics are based.



COSTS

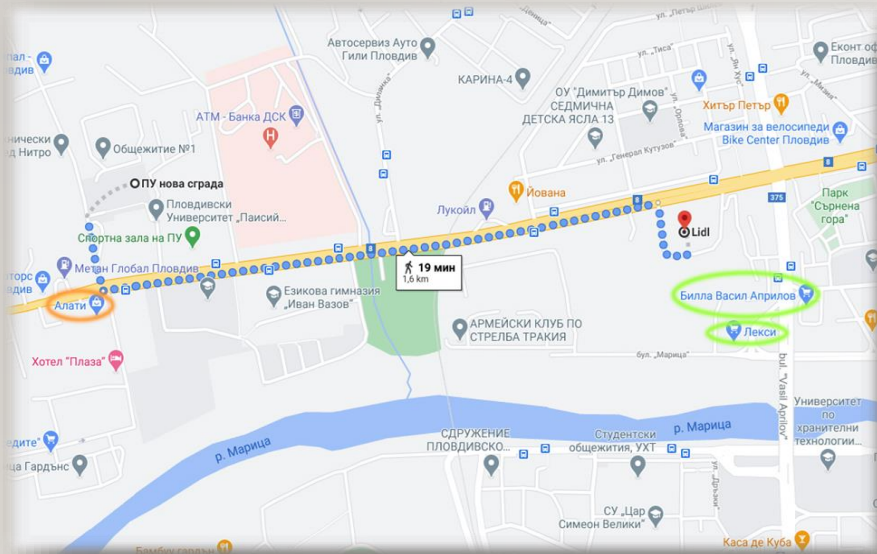
- The rent is *100 leva (50 EUR)* per month.
- There are **no extra bills** for electricity, water, heating, Wi-Fi Internet (available 24/7), etc.
- There is a one-time maintenance fee of *100 leva (50 EUR)*.
- Every month, the students in the dorm may agree between themselves to pay a small amount of money for some laundry essentials – detergent, fabric softener, etc.

It is very important for the students to keep their rooms clean and tidy, as well as the space in front of them, as the manager may come every so often to check if everything is in good condition.



FOOD & DRINKS

- There is *no kitchen available* in the dormitories. However, there is a canteen, in the New Campus, where students have a discount and can have lunch. The canteen works on weekdays only.
- Cooking is prohibited in the rooms but the use of kettles and microwaves is allowed.



A short walk from the New Campus down the Bulgaria boulevard will take the students to the closest supermarket (*Lidl*) where they will also find some other stores for electronics, domestic appliances and other household goods. Two more supermarkets are located in the near vicinity (*Billa* and *Leksi*).



TAKEAWAYS

If you have missed getting some food at the canteen or it is the weekend, you could also just order.

There are many food delivery companies in Plovdiv which offer a great variety of meals.





LIVING

- The remoteness of the dormitories from the city center (approximately 6-7 kilometers away) is a factor that helps with one's training as it offers less distractions. There are, however, also students who prefer self-accommodation nearer the center.
- Public transport is available. Regular buses take you to the heart of the city for a quarter of an hour. The cost of a ticket is 1 lev (0,5 EUR).
- Buses **4**, **20**, **44** connect the dormitories and the center, and **20**, **222** can be used if you want to reach the Central Railway Station (as there are a lot of roadworks in the city, it is best to double-check the current route of the bus line you want to use beforehand).





FACTS

- Each year, the ***IRO*** tries to reserve as many rooms as possible for our foreign students. But there is still no guarantee that everyone will be accommodated. The first to apply have higher chances of securing a room.
